
2019 District Stat Highlights...

Ferry County Health


- Clinic total visits 2019 = 10,709

- Imaging & Swing Bed Days all are also slightly up year over year





Major Announcement #2...

The District has entered into an Agreement with the Rob & Patty Slagle to purchase Republic Drug

- Rob and Patty working towards retirement Slagle owned since 1904 Rob has served the community since 1982 and Patty since 1984
- Right Independent Pharmacists not found
- Pharmacy revenue will contribute towards long term goal of debt payoff
- District offers stability and will continue with the same model/location/etc.
- Rob and Patty will stay on for a period to insure a smooth transition (and will be available for pharmacists coverage)
