First, you may be wondering what DO stands for since we are accustomed to seeing MD, Medical Doctor or Doctor of Medicine following the name. DO stands for Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine. The difference in the two stems from differences in teaching styles and focus during medical schools. Both attend four years of medical school and complete the same residency programs. Emphasis in DO education is on the whole patient rather than just on the diseased or injured part, however MD education is shifting now to a more “whole person” look. Dr. Garcia also can increase our services practice with manipulation therapy.

Dr. Garcia grew up in Kalamazo, Michigan and earned his BA & MA at Michigan State University in East Lansing. He then earned his DO at West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine, located in Lewisburg. This school is one of 19 DO schools in the US, and is rated #1 in Rural Primary Care. He completed his residency in Chicago.
