Interim CEO named at hospital

REPUBLIC — The Ferry County Public Hospital District board of directors has named an interim CEO to replace former CEO Brenda Parnell at the regular monthly meeting last Thursday.

Terali Stonehocker, formerly appointed as the temporary CEO, has taken the interim position until a new CEO has been found. The district has started its search for a permanent executive.

Stonehocker was previously the hospital's Chief Nursing Officer for the past two years and has been with the district

for 42 years overall.

The board also decided to terminate a preliminary contract with the accountable care organization the district was trying to join. Due to not having a full-time CEO and being unable to find health care providers who want to join the ACO, the board decided to end attempts to join about a month before the deadline.

The timing for the district isn't right, board chair Nancy Betschart said. Without a CEO, the board will have to table discussions about joining an ACO until a replacement has been found.
