In 1958, a resolution commemorating the day was adopted by the United States House of Representative and in 1990, President George Bush signed a resolution which became Public Law designating March 30th as National Doctor's Day.

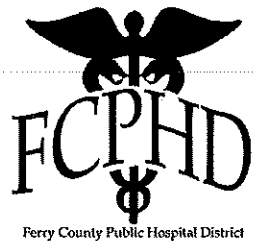
