RESOLUTION 2023 #5

A resolution of the Ferry County Health Board of Commissioners declaring acceptance of DEA and US Attorney proposed Memorandum of Understanding and Settlement in the amount of \$15,000.

Whereas, The Ferry County Health Board of Commissioners acknowledges that the DEA and US Attorney's office found "red flags" surrounding the operations at the Republic Drugstore, and

Whereas, The Ferry County Health Board of Commissioners, Superintendent and relevant staff have participated in researching red flags and proposing compensating policies and procedure to monitor and prevent "red flag" activity, and

Whereas, The Ferry County Health Board of Commissioners, Superintendent and relevant staff have acknowledged that although the Board has questions and the facts were not substantiated, they want a good working relationship with the DEA as owners of the Republic Drugstore and are conscientious and aware of our opioid crisis but also of the need for pain management, and

Whereas, the Ferry County Health Board of Commissioners will utilize the agreement as guidelines for future operations of the Republic Drugstore in relation to opioid prescription fulfillment.

Therefore be it resolved, that the Ferry County Health Board of Commissioners do hereby adopt, support, and will facilitate the US Attorney's office Letter of Agreement and Settlement implementation as deemed appropriate.
